<u>Maths</u>

This half term, we will continue to look at place value of numbers up to 100 understanding what each number represents. We will also be counting forwards and backwards in steps of 2, 5 and 10s. Once we have practised counting in 2, 5 and 10s we will be using these numbers to work out division number sentences. We will be looking at different practical methods to add and subtract numbers to 100. Using these methods we will be beginning to try and solve problems.

This half term our theme is 'Rio de Vida'. We will be finding out lots about Brazil and focusing particularly on the Rio carnival.

Within our English lessons, we will make links with the theme to support our writing of postcards, stories about Brazilian myths and instructions to make a Brazilian snack.

In our music lessons we will be focusing on what a percussion instrument is, how we can play the instrument, how we can make it loud or quiet and play it in time with a piece of music. We will also be comparing British and Brazilian music.

In Geography we will be looking at maps and globes, learning the names of the different continents and oceans and finding where Brazil and the United Kingdom are. When we have located Brazil we will be looking at what it is like as a country and comparing it to the United Kingdom.

In our art & design technology sessions we will be making carnival head dresses and Brazilian instruments ready for a carnival day.

In computing we will be looking at the film Rio and creating puppets from this. With the puppets we will be creating and filming our own scenes of the film.

Also, during our Dance (P.E.) lessons we will be practising our own carnival dance based on the film Rio. Outside PE we will be practising a range of skills such as running through obstacles, throwing and catching and aiming.
