Maths

This half term, we will be looking at money; what coins and notes we have in British money, making totals and how to work out change. We will also be looking at fractions, working out a half, quarters and thirds of shapes and numbers, length and height, looking at what we measure in and measuring lots of different objects and people. We will be finishing off the half term by recapping different methods we know to add and subtract and using these to solve problems.

This half term our theme is 'Bounce'. We will be investigating using different balls, finding out about the famous footballer Pele and creating our cars to race.

In English this half term we writing information pages based on a famous person to do with sport. We will also be using the text 'The Frog Prince' to write a narrative based on a special parcel we will find and ending the half term writing our own shape poems.

In our History lessons, we will be looking at Pele, his life history and how he became so famous. From this we will be using our information we have found out to create posters and fact books about him.

In Science we will be doing lots investigations. We will start by finding out which ball bounces the highest, what happens to bubbles on a windy day and who can jump higher than an animal. After this the children will be working in teams to create their own science investigation starting with posing a question. Then making a prediction before finally collecting results and evaluating their findings.

In our Art & Design technology sessions we will be looking at the artist Jackson Pollok and using his style to create our own artwork. In DT we will be working out how to make balloon cars, designing and racing them.

Indoor PE this half term is gymnastics. We will be using balls to create a routine.

In outdoor PE will be continuing to look at improving our skills of running, jumping, kicking, throwing and catching and how we can apply these into different games.
