Pupil Premium Funding is allocated to each school by the government in order to ensure that all groups of children have the opportunity to achieve well. The funding is allocated to pupils who are entitled to or have previously been entitled to free school meals (FSM), are 'looked after' or have been adopted or belong to 'service families'.

The Pathfinder C of E Primary School Pupil Premium Funding for the financial year 2018-2019 is £8853.
