

Our theme is:



This term our theme is 'Journeys'. We will think about ways to travel, places we visit and faraway places on Earth.

In Literacy, we will retell stories with puppets, props, drawings and use our own imagination. There will be also be many opportunities for mark making and emergent writing.

In Maths, we will be recognising numbers 0 - 10, counting in order from 0-10 and practising writing numbers for example in paint or sand. We will be identifying shapes in the environment and using positional language.

In Physical Development, we will be dancing to music, focusing on spatial awareness and playing coordination games.

At home you can.....

- Talk about a journey you've been on, how did you travel? Where did you go? If you haven't been on a journey, where would you go? What would you pack? How would you travel?
- Create a model of a form of transport. This could be using cardboard boxes, Lego, Duplo or anything else you have at home.
- Make a boat and test out if it floats or sinks in water. Can your boat carry any objects?
- Read information books about travelling and transport. You could look at a map or atlas and talk about how you will travel to different places.

In Expressive Arts and Design, we will be joining materials to make vehicles and drawing using different types of lines. We will be singing songs and rhymes as well as moving to music.
