Welcome to Little Owls!

The children enjoyed our theme 'Signs of Spring' before Easter where we learnt about the changes in weather and nature as we go into Spring. We are now going to be looking at a new theme 'Ready, Steady, Grow!' In the first week we will be planting seeds and talking about how they grow.

Our theme is 'Ready, Steady, Grow!'

Firstly we will be looking at how seeds grow into plants by planting our own seeds in the pre-school garden. We will be looking at animals and their babies in the following weeks.

In Literacy, we will be sharing our favourite stories about animal babies such as 'Monkey Puzzle' and 'On the Farm'.

In Maths, we are going to look at patterns in nature such as the farmers' fields.

In Physical Development, the children will have the opportunity to be creative with different coloured materials, using their fine and gross motor skills.
