

How we will spend our Pupil Premium funding 2017-2018?

Pupil Premium Funding is allocated to each school by the government in order to ensure that all groups of children have the opportunity to achieve well. The funding is allocated to pupils who are entitled to or have previously been entitled to free school meals (FSM), are 'looked after' or have been adopted or belong to 'service families'.

The Pathfinder C of E Primary School Pupil Premium Funding for the financial year 2017-2018 is expected to be approximately £1540. As a new school, this is calculated for 7/12 of the total amount, backdated to September when the school opens.

We have focussed on what is the most effective and best value taking in to account the needs of our individual pupils and our current School Development Plan priorities. We value early intervention so that our pupils have the best opportunities to fulfil their full potential and hopefully, exceed their expectations of themselves!
